

The City of Springfield has organized a Task Force to begin considering Stormwater Management moving forward. This process will include:

- The development of a Stormwater Ordinance and all that may come with that.
- Mapping the stormwater system in order to develop a Stormwater Model.
- Development of a Stormwater model that will expose issues and choke points.
- Develop a corrective action plan.
- Develop a financial model to assist in paying for the corrections.

Please know that this is a long-term process and will not be done overnight. It will be slow and methodical and will concentrate on the worst places <u>as the model tells</u> <u>us.</u>

The bulk of the existing storm system was built 75 years ago and is just too small (undersized hydraulically) for the town as we now know it.

One of the initial items of business will be a survey to determine where the public sees drainage issues related to <u>their own property and location</u>.


