CITY OF SPRINGFIELD ORDINANCE NO. 2023-908 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION III OF ORDINANCE NO. 2007-010 OCCUPATIONAL LUCENSE TAX

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION III. Occupational License Tax Payment Required

- (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, every person or business entity engaged in any business for profit and any person or business entity that is required to make a filing with the Internal Revenue Service or the Kentucky Revenue Cabinet shall be required to file and pay to the city an occupational license tax for the privilege of engaging in such activities within the city. The occupational license tax shall be measured by one-percent(44%) one and one half percent (1.5%) of:
 - all wages and compensation paid in the city for work done or services performed or rendered in the city on forms supplied by the City by every resident and nonresident who is an employee;
 - (b) the net profits from business conducted in the city by a resident or nonresident business entity on forms supplied by the City.
